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FULL DESCRIPTION OF TRAINING CONTENTS

IN THE LANGUAGE OF THE TRAINING: (EN)

Preparation* This course has been created for people involved in welcoming processes or for members involved in respect of rights as in educative areas. This course is especially suited for persons newly appointed to position of responsibility. No pre-preparation requirements, only characters of their own organization to share experiences and compare processes, host organization will share with participant a community platform and didactical tools before the course.

Objectives* Participants:
will increase their knowledge about stereotypes, prejudices, racism and discrimination. As targets, they :
will gain ideas and strategies for teaching these issues
will be sensitized about different manifestations of discrimination and racism
will understand important concepts related to the issues and that they have spent time thinking through their own perceptions
will learn and tried out several practical methods which they can then use to increase students/participants intercultural competences
will by the end of the programme have developed an idea about how they can organize a training themselves for different groups in their own country.
will learn how to deliver this training to groups that have a negative attitude/s toward migrants and/or other minority groups.

Methodology* The training program demands full participation from the participants. The main method will be through cooperative work, various activities, discussions and practical training practises. The lectures will be short and will take place between the activities. A key objective is always learning by doing. All participants should be able to discuss and present simple activities of their country. We plan to do outdoor activities and visits to Italian institutions

Follow-up* Participants will have a better understanding of key-competences in intercultural activities. Host organization will realize a common shared platform among participants, then a bridge with older participants to share results, materials and new activities.

PROGRAMME OF THE TRAINING ACTIVITIES (DAY BY DAY)

IN THE Arrival Day: SUN (before the course)

1 Day: MON

09:00 Introduction of the session, the trainers and the participants. Work on constructing the feeling of safety and trust within a group through various activities.

14:30 Models of education in formative institutions and how these methods can be transferred to adult education.

17:30 Outdoor activities in Rome

2 Day: TUE

09:00 Activities as a method to teach about sensitive matters, focusing on adults/ teenagers and young adults immigrants in Italy

14:30 Success stories and group exercises, visit to Musei Capitolini in Capitol Hill in Rome

3 Day: WED

09:00 Examples of a training programme for adults. the Prometeo experience, visit of institution involved in activity against racism

14:30 visit of institutions and University of Rome, visit to Vatican hill and the welcoming experience in the history of Rome

4 Day: THU

09:00 Discussion and slides about the advantages of diversity. Discussion about other methods and teaching techniques to reach an unmotivated group.

14:30 Group work – Participants start working on their own program or teaching plan.

5 Day: FRI

09:00 Presentation of the results of the group work.

Discussion and evaluation of the training programme.

14:30 Evaluation session, discussion on further cooperation on the Internet where the participants continue sharing their experiences using common platform.

17:30 outdoor activities in Rome

7 Day: SAT

09:00 visit of Rome and experiences of welcoming, final ceremony, time to say good-bye. Departure from Rome, bus to Airport
